

CALL FOR SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE MOLECULAR ONCOLOGY MASTER 2024-2025

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The candidate must hold:
 - a) **Bachelor, MD, MS or PHD in Medicine** and have (or performing now) one of these specialties: Clinical Oncology, Pathology, Hematology or Radiotherapy.
 - b) **Bachelor or PHD in any of these careers in the biosciences area**: Biology, Pharmacy, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Biomedicine.
- 2. Complete the standardized CV in online format from whose veracity is responsible. The applicant may be required to demonstrate any of the merits during the selection process.

The deadline for admission of applications for the regular registration of the Master's degree in Molecular Oncology is **May 30, 2024**, both days inclusive. In case of vacancies for the extraordinary enrollment in September 2024, applications will be accepted from July 15 to August 15, 2024, both days inclusive.

To apply for a scholarship during the regular enrollment period, you must complete and submit the standardized CV in online format by May 30, 2024, and you are responsible for its accuracy, and may be required to demonstrate or expand on any of the merits during the selection process.

SCHOLARSHIPS AMOUNT

There are available partial scholarships (1800 \in and 3600 \in) for academic excellence, to be deducted from the total cost of the program.

These scholarships are not compatible with any other discount available.

For the scholarship to be awarded, the beneficiary must pay a reservation fee of 1100€ (one thousand one hundred euros). This reservation will be counted as part of the payment of the Master's tuition fee.

The scholarship/grant awarded will be considered as income of non-residents, being applicable the provisions of the Double Taxation Agreement between Spain and the country of residence of the beneficiary of the scholarship, in case of existence of such agreement. For this purpose, if selected, the candidate must provide a **certificate of tax residence** in his/her country. Otherwise, the scholarship will be subject to taxation at the Non-Resident Personal Income Tax rate of 24%.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1. The candidate must complete the standardized CV in online format **before May 30, 2024**. Applications whose mandatory fields have not been completed will be rejected.
- 2. The applications received will be evaluated based on the merits reflected in the CV. Candidates from developing countries will have priority.
- 3. Candidates may be required for an online interview.
- 4. Once the CVs are evaluated, the scholarship award decision will be unappealable.
- 5. The decision, whether favorable or unfavorable, will be communicated to the candidate.
